SelfRefind: Now a Behavioral Health Service Organization

DANVILLE, KY. – SelfRefind, a privately owned group specializing in addiction treatment, is now a Behavioral Health Services Organization (BHSO). The license allows the group to offer addiction and recovery care to patients enrolled in Kentucky Medicaid.

“This designation makes SelfRefind one of the few BHSO’s in Kentucky,” SelfRefind CEO Jamie Durham said. “It allows us to boost addiction treatment and provide expanded support to more people who want to go into recovery but can’t afford treatment.”

SelfRefind also has obtained an Alcohol & Other Drug Entity (AODE) license, which is required for BHSO’s providing outpatient behavioral health services to treat those with substance abuse disorder.

SelfRefind plans to start accepting Medicaid in early spring.

“People come to us when they’re ready to get their lives back,” Durham said. “Our approach is proven, and now it’s even stronger. No one is beyond addiction treatment, and we’re continually working to be sure those who need our services have access.”

SelfRefind offers an outpatient addiction treatment program using medication combined with office visits, counseling, recovery assessment and laboratory services to assist patients in addiction recovery.

SelfRefind has 16 locations in Kentucky, including Lexington and Louisville, and four in Ohio.
