New Evansville Addiction Treatment Center Opens to Help Fight Opioid Epidemic

Danville, KY. – SelfRefind, a CARF accredited organization and leader in outpatient addiction treatment has announced the expansion of its integrated care recovery services with the launch of the company’s 20th clinic and first in the state of Indiana. The first center in Evansville, located at 4847 East Virginia Avenue, will start seeing patients later this month, and is the first of several locations planned for Indiana over the next two years.

SelfRefind’s mission is to “*Save Lives, Instill Hope and Restore Relationships*” utilizing an integrated care model comprised of physician services, behavioral health counseling, case management and patient education. Today, SelfRefind provides local and affordable care for over 4,000 fellow human beings in Kentucky and Ohio. The expansion into Indiana is focused on helping communities hit hard by the opioid epidemic.

“The opioid epidemic is taking an extreme toll on the lives of far too many Americans. Indiana, like other states, has seen a dramatic increase in drug overdoses.” said Steve Priest, CEO. “Our team is not only focused on enhancing the lives of the patients we serve, but in helping rebuild Indiana communities impacted by addiction. It is our desire to be an active member of the local healthcare community and a partner in the fight against this deadly disease.”

According to the Indiana State Department of Health, emergency room visits due to non-fatal drug overdoses have risen by 60 percent over a 5-year period and in 2016 alone 365 people died from drug overdose.

“There is no one-size fits all approach to addiction treatment which is why SelfRefind tailors every treatment plan to match the unique needs of each individual,” said David Hayden, LCADC, VP of Clinical Operations. “It’s essential we provide a community based option, offering multiple services as the drug epidemic grows spanning all demographics and socio-economic backgrounds. Our model is evidenced based and designed to keep individuals in their communities throughout treatment allowing them to continue working, caring for their families, and ultimately enhancing their quality of life.”

SelfRefind participates with Indiana Medicaid and is currently accepting new patients from select commercial insurance plans. “We look forward to bringing addiction treatment solutions to Evansville to help ease the worsening of this epidemic, and our team is working
